

Create A Toolbar For My Computer

If you frequently access your drives or DUN (dial-up networking) connections through the My Computer icon on your Desktop (Windows 98/Me/2000/XP), you can simplify things and create a My Computer toolbar. Click the My Computer icon and drag it to the top or either side of your Desktop. Release the mouse button, and Windows creates a toolbar that displays the contents of My Computer. You can drag the edges of the toolbar to resize it. You can also edit toolbar options by right-clicking the toolbar and selecting an option from the context menu that appears. This tip works for any folder on your Desktop, and you can combine toolbars by dragging one on top of another.
